

Flood Control Fire-Related Sediment Hauling

NOTICE

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works operates and maintains the flood control facilities, Bradbury and Spinks Debris Basins in the City of Bradbury. During the recent storms, a significant amount of sediment and debris has eroded into the basins from the hillsides burned by the recent Fish Fire. To restore the basin's storage capacity and ability to protect downstream residents and property, the Department needs to remove and haul the sediment and debris.

TRUCK HAUL ROUTE

Trucks will arrive in the morning entering the gate at Lemon Avenue and Winston Avenue. Sediment and debris will be transported by trucks and will follow the route shown on the attached map. The sediment will be taken to a disposal site located near Arrow Highway and Vincent Avenue in the City of Irwindale.

HOURS/DAY

Trucks are scheduled to begin hauling sediment on **Monday, January 30, 2017**. The hauling operation will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (weather permitting). Hauling will also continue on Saturdays and possibly Sundays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and may last approximately 8 weeks, subject to clear weather conditions.
