2. Discussion – Emergency Response Committee Appointment and Committee Composition

At the June 25, 2013, the City Council reappointed members of the Emergency Response Committee to ten (10) vacancies to be filled due to all expiring terms. Additionally, in February 2013 the City Council adopted Resolution No. 13-03 establishing the Emergency Response Committee as an official committee and established terms for membership. Since late 2014 the ERC has not been able to meet due to a lack of quorum. This evening the City Council will make one appointment and discuss the composition of the Committee.

3. Discussion – Parks and Facilities Need Assessment

The City is participating in the Los Angeles County initiative known as the Parks and Need Assessment. This initiative involves holding community engagement workshops throughout Los Angeles County to identify park projects that are considered a community priority and which might be considered for funding in a future measure. The City held a community meeting on January 12, 2016 and the City Council is requested to review the results and discuss the matter.

4. Discussion – Authorization to Replace the Existing Solar Speed Feedback Signs on Mount Olive Drive

Based on a failure from Siemens Industry, Inc. to provide a timely response to the repair of the existing speed feedback signs on Mount Olive Drive it is recommended that the City Council authorize staff to issue a Purchase Order to Steiny and Company, Inc. to replace the existing solar speed feedback signs and to enter into an annual maintenance contract.
