

ORDINANCE NO. 338

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY, CALIFORNIA
AMENDING ARTICLE III CHAPTER 1 OF THE BRADBURY MUNICIPAL CODE PROVIDING
PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON BRAEWOOD DRIVE AND WOODLYN LANE**

(BRADBURY MUNICIPAL CODE ARTICLE III CHAPTER 1)

WHEREAS, The City of Bradbury, County of Los Angeles, State of California is charged with the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bradbury is authorized to regulate public rights of ways and traffic within City boundaries; and

WHEREAS, The City Council hereby determines that parking prohibitions and restrictions upon said streets will best protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens. The City Manager is authorized to have said area posted with signs, in accordance with the provisions set forth hereinabove.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Chapter 1 is hereby amended to Article III of the Bradbury Municipal Code, Traffic Regulations, to read as follows:

3202. Stopping, Standing or Parking on City Streets During Certain Hours.

No person shall park any motor vehicle or leave standing any motor vehicle for a period exceeding two (2) hours between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on every day except Sunday on those certain public streets within the City of Bradbury hereinafter set forth:

1. Braewood Drive.

3204. No Parking Areas.

No person at any time shall park any motor vehicle except as may be necessary to comply with an order or command of any law enforcement officer on any streets or portions of streets hereinafter set forth.

1. Woodlyn Lane, outside the gated area, both sides, for the entire length thereof.

SECTION 2: Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause a summary thereof to be published and/or posted in accordance with law.
