

**ORDINANCE NO. 324**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY AMENDING  
THE BRADBURY MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR  
CONTRACTING SERVICE TO THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES  
(BRADBURY MUNICIPAL CODE ARTICLE I CHAPTER 2 ADDING SECTION 1211)**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Bradbury City Council considered the subject matter hereof as part of  
its June 19, 2012 Regular Meeting and finds, determines and declares as follows:

A. It is in the best interest of the City to amend the Bradbury Municipal Code to  
include provisions and property authority to the County of Los Angeles when  
serving as agents, employees or representatives for the City of Bradbury

SECTION 2: Effective August 19, 2012, the following Section of the Bradbury Municipal  
Code is amended to read as follows:

**ARTICLE I – GENERAL PROVISIONS  
CHAPTER 2 – RULES OF CONSTRUCTION**

**1211- Contracts with Los Angeles Country.**

The City Council may contract with the County of Los Angeles pursuant to the  
laws of the State of California and the Charter of the County of Los Angeles, for  
the performance and execution by designated County officials of the rights,  
powers and duties of officers, officials and employees of the City of Bradbury.  
Whenever in this Code, whether set forth in full or by adoption by reference, any  
power or authority is granted to an officer, official or employee, such power or  
authority is conferred upon the appropriate officer, official or employee of the  
City of Bradbury, or if none, by the appropriate officer, official or employee of the  
County of Los Angeles whose service on behalf of the City is provided for by a  
contract with the County of Los Angeles, or their respective designee.


SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the  
decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity  
of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it  
would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision,  
sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or  
more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions  
thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: The City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this ordinance and shall  
cause the summary thereof to be published within fifteen (15) days of the adoption and

shall post a certified copy of this Ordinance, including the vote for and against the same, in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance will become effective on the thirty-first (31<sup>st</sup>) day following its adoption.


