

ORDINANCE NO. 325

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY AMENDING BRADBURY MUNICIPAL CODE ARTICLE II CHAPTER 8 SECTIONS 2802 AND 2807 REGARDING BIDDING PROCEDURES AND AMOUNTS FOR PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY HEREBY ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2802 Article II Chapter 8, of the Bradbury Municipal Code is hereby amended to read the following:

2802. Contracting Procedures.

Public Projects of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) or less may preformed by City employees by force account, by negotiated contract or by purchase order. Public projects of one-hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) or less may be let to contract by informal procedures as set forth in this chapter. Public projects of more than one-hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) shall, except as provided in Section 2807 be let by formal bidding procedure in accordance with the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act.

SECTION 2. Section 2807 Article II Chapter 8, of the Bradbury Municipal Code is hereby amended to read the following:


2807. Procedure When All Bids Exceed One Hundred and Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$175,000)

This section shall govern the award of contracts when all bids received are in excess of one-hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000). The City Council may, by passage of a resolution by four-fifths vote, award the contract at one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) or less to the lowest responsible bidder, if it determines the City's cost estimate was reasonable.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby declares it would have passed this ordinance sentence by sentence, paragraph by paragraph, and section by section, and does hereby declare that the provisions of this ordinance are severable and, if for any reason any sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance, and the City Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be posted or published as prescribed by law.


