PROJECT LOCATION: 406 Mount Olive Drive, Bradbury

The City of Bradbury City Council is seeking input from residents, property owners and interested individuals or groups regarding an appeal of the Planning Commission approval of the above-mentioned planning applications.

Project Description: A new, two-story, 6,232 square-foot, Spanish-style single-family residence, and remodeling of the existing one-story, 1,704 square-foot residence to a Spanish-style, accessory living quarter.
