
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Bradbury will conduct a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, March 23, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.** in the Civic Center City Council Chambers at, 600 Winston Avenue, Bradbury, to consider the following item:

Architectural Review AR 16-002 Neighborhood Compatibility NC 16-002

LOCATION: 100 Sycamore, Bradbury

The City of Bradbury Planning Commission is seeking input from residents, property owners and interested individuals or groups regarding the above-mentioned planning applications.

Project Description: This is a request to demolish an existing residence and construct a new residence, accessory unit and landscape amenities. The site 8.16 acres in size and zoned A-5 (five-acre minimum lot size). It is currently developed with an 8,554 square foot primary residence (constructed in 1990 and altered in 1995), pool and tennis court. The request is to demolish all existing site improvements and construct a new primary residence 18,349 square feet in size, a guest-house of 2,500 square feet and new recreation/landscape amenities. The major architectural review is required for the addition over 1,000 square feet. The neighborhood compatibility is required for the construction of a structure that exceeds one story.




The City of Bradbury Planning Department is recommending that the proposed project is Categorically Exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15332 (In-Fill Development) of the CEQA Guidelines.

The applicant and all persons either favoring or opposing this proposal are invited to present their views at this public hearing. If you challenge the action taken on this proposal in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City.

The public is invited to view the material between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. All interested parties are invited to attend the public hearing and provide testimony relevant to the project.
