2. PUBLIC HEARING – Reading of Ordinance No. 325: An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Bradbury Amending Chapter 8 of the Bradbury Municipal Code Increasing the Monetary Limit for Public Works Projects

The "Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act" establishes the required amounts for public works projects to be awarded through formal bidding procedures and informal bidding procedures. This state law was recently amended to increase the amounts for public work projects. Recommendation that the City Council conduct a public hearing and read for the first time by title only Ordinance No. 325.

3. DISCUSSION – City of Bradbury Fiscal Sustainability – Appointments to the Finance Committee

The City Council will make appointments to the City's Finance Committee. The Committee has been established to assist the City Council with determining solutions to the City's ongoing fiscal sustainability issues. The Committee will meet as needed and provide an update to the City Council in the fall of 2012 in order to provide ample time if necessary for a ballot measure in Spring 2013. The City Council will review applications submitted by the Community and may or may not make appointments.

4. DISCUSSION – Long-term Revenue Solutions to Reduce Taxes in Bradbury for Sustainable Viability and/or Cost Savings

The City Council will consider ideas and comments from residents regarding long-term solutions or cost savings to the City's fiscal challenges, specifically potential strategies for enhancing and creating new revenue. New items include the 3 Peaks of Bradbury event, Community Yard Sale and Adopt a Street Light.


