

## Election FAQ

The City of Bradbury elects its City Council Members by District. Elections for Member of the City Council are held in April of even-numbered years.

- **When is the next City Election?**

The next election will be held in April of 2010 for Districts Three and Five. The next election for Districts One, Two and Four will be in April 2012.

- **What District do I live in?**

Please refer to the District Boundary map ([link to District Map](#)) or call the City Clerk at City Hall (626) 358-3218.

- **How can I run for City Council?**

In order to run for elective office you must be 18 years or older and a registered voter in the City of Bradbury. You must reside in the District that you are running for office/seat.

- **How and where do I register to vote?**

Voter registration forms are available at City Hall and get mailed to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk for processing. For voter registration information please contact the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk at (562) 466-1323.
