

ORDINANCE NO. 307
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY
AMENDING THE MEETING TIME OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS
(BRADBURY MUNICIPAL CODE ARTICLE II CHAPTER 1 SECTION 2100)

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRADBURY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Bradbury City Council considered the subject matter hereof as part of its May 26, 2009 Regular Meeting and finds, determines and declares as follows:

A. It is in the best interest of the City to amend the time of City Council Regular Meetings for purposes of generating more community involvement in the meetings and to better accommodate the schedule of City staff and officials.

B. In order to change the Regular Meeting time of the City Council it is necessary to amend Bradbury Municipal Code Article II, Chapter 1, Section 2100.

SECTION 2: Effective July 1, 2009, the following Sections of the Bradbury Municipal Code are amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE II - ADMINISTRATION
CHAPTER 1 - CITY COUNCIL

2100 Council Meetings.

There shall be one regular meeting of the City Council during each calendar month and such meeting shall be held on the third Tuesday thereof at the hour of 7:00 p.m. provided, however, that if the date of any such regular meeting falls on a holiday, said regular meeting shall be held at the hour of 7:00 p.m. on the next succeeding day which is not a holiday.

If by reason of some emergency, it shall be unsafe to meet in the City Hall, the meetings may be held for the duration of the emergency at such other place as is designated by the Mayor, or, if the Mayor should fail to act, by a majority of the City Council.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective

of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: The City Clerk shall certify as to the adoption of this ordinance and shall cause the summary thereof to be published within fifteen (15) days of the adoption and shall post a certified copy of this Ordinance, including the vote for and against the same, in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance will become effective on the thirty-first (31st) day following its adoption.
