## Looking for A Treasurer

Do you want to become involved with the community? The City of Bradbury will be appointing a City Treasurer during the Council Meeting on April 17<sup>th</sup>. The City Treasurer is appointed for a term of two years. The duties of this position include but are not limited to:

- Receiving and safely keep all monies coming into the treasury;
- Paying money only to warrants signed by legally designated persons;
- Submitting a monthly written report and accounting of receipts, disbursements, and fund balances to the City Clerk and the City Council;
- Performing such duties relating to the collection of the City taxes and license fees as are prescribed by ordinance; and,
- Rendering to the City Council an annual statement of investment policy and quarterly reports.

## Oak View Estates Scoping Meeting

As the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City of Bradbury is reviewing the environmental impacts of the Oak View Estates Specific Plan and invites your input. You are invited to the Oak View Estates Plan Scoping Meeting on Wednesday, March 14, 2018 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Bradbury Civic Center.

The Oak View Estates Specific Plan, in conjunction with Tentative Tract Map 73567, would guide the development of 197.7 acres of an undeveloped hillside site. Development would result in nice new residential estate lots with accessory dwelling units, bridges, a loop access road, and conservation areas.

Mountain lions cubs Olive and Leno (known as the “Burbank Kittens”) were found under a car in Burbank in 2011 after wandering out of the Verdugos and away from their mother. They were very malnourished, full of parasites and incredibly scared. After receiving rehab care in Calabasas and living at ZooToYou in Paso Robles for two years, Animazonia Wildlife Foundation took them in and became their lifetime sanctuary. Animazonia has been rescuing BIG CATS since 1987 and four of Bradbury’s residents are Board members and founders of the nonprofit organization.
