Los Angeles County Recovery Updates

The Los Angeles County is taking initial steps towards reopening businesses and reconstituting some operations. The re-opening of businesses will occur in stages and will require social distancing practices. Businesses that are reopened include:

- Lower-Risk Businesses (Curbside, door side, outdoor pickup or via delivery only)
- Retailers that are not located within an Indoor Mall or Shopping Center.
- Manufacturing and logistics sector businesses that supply lower risk retail businesses.
- Outdoor Recreation, Outdoor Facilities, Parks, and other open spaces
- Bike paths
- County beaches are open for active recreation activities such as swimming, surfing and running/walking only; no chairs, canopies, or sunbathing allowed. Beach parking lots, bike paths, boardwalks, volleyball courts and piers remain closed.
