



Water Billing Discrepancies

At the March 17th City Council meeting residents and City Council members voiced their concerns to California American Water representatives about billing practices especially "estimated" billing. Cal-Am water representatives have stated that a number of Bradbury residents have been billed on "estimated" service due to a number of different factors, including difficulty in accessing meters, poor radio reception, and other technical issues. Amounts paid from estimated bills are adjusted once a true reading has been made, customers are then credited any balance on future bills. Many of these billing discrepancies are the result of a lack of automated radio operated meters in the City. California American Water has stated that approximately 1/3 of Bradbury water meters are automated, and that replacements are being made on a gradual basis. Bradbury residents are advised to take an extra look at their water bills. If you have an estimated water bill please provide the City with a copy and contact Cal-Am at 1-888-422-5268 to report your concern. Where: *Monrovia High School, 845 W. Colorado Blvd.*

Cost: **Free!**

Examples of Household Hazard Waste include brake fluid, paint, paint thinner, cleaners with acid or lye, pesticides or herbicides, household batteries and car batteries, pool chemicals, motor oil, filters, and expired pharmaceuticals. E-Waste includes computer monitors, televisions, CPU's, printers. Please bring items in a sturdy box, preferably in their original labeled containers. Please acknowledge Hazardous waste limit of 15 gallons per trip.
